

# Trees, Plants and Shrubs of Panther Creek State Park

Wildflowers flourish in the park's rich soils. In the spring, expect to see Cut-leaf Toothwort, Virginia Spring Beauty, Indian Pink, Wild Blue Phlox and Trout Lily blooming along the park trails. During the summer and early fall, Milkweed, Queen Anne's Lace, Butterfly Weed, Joe Pye Weed, Goldenrod and Ironweed can be seen blooming in the park fields.

Common deciduous trees found in the park include Black Walnut, Persimmon, Sassafras, Hickory, Oak, American Beech, Tulip, Dogwood, Redbud, Sycamore, Black Cherry, Box Elder and American Elm, while the predominate evergreen trees include Eastern Red Cedar, Virginia Pine and Shortleaf Pine.
